## **Speaker For September: Iris H. W. Engstrand**

Iris H. W. Engstrand, Professor of History at the University of San Diego, is a native Californian who attended Newport Harbor High School. She received her B.A., M.A. and Ph.D. in history from the University of Southern California, where her major fields were California, Mexico, Latin America and the Spanish Southwest. Dr. Engstrand has taught a variety of courses at USD since 1968 and is author of 21 books, including *San Diego: California's Cornerstone*; *San Diego: Gateway to the Pacific*; *Spanish Scientists in the New World*; and *Arizona Hispanica*. She has lived and traveled extensively in Spain and Mexico, writing articles and lecturing in English and Spanish.



Dr. Engstrand has co-authored several books with her University of San Diego graduate students. These include histories of San Diego Natural History Museum and the University of San Diego. Her academic honors include USD's distinguished University Professorship, the Davies Award for Faculty Achievement, Awards of Merit from the California, Southern California and San Diego Historical Societies, Western History Association, and Orange Coast College; fellowships from the Fulbright Commission, American Philosophical Society and Huntington Library. She is a Trustee for the San Diego Natural History Museum, past president of the American Historical Association, Pacific Coast Branch, and president of the Western History Association (2003-2004).

## ***Casa De Cuna Needs Us!***

Have you ever painted anything? Do you know how to speak Spanish? Do you have a spare filing cabinet that has a lock on it? Any one of these things would help the sisters of the Casa de Cuna orphanage in Tijuana.

Five Jaycees took a trip with Juan Mora, our speaker for August, to visit Casa de Cuna on September 18<sup>th</sup>. Juan is an extremely entertaining speaker and tour guide as anyone who has ever traveled with him, or even just SPOKEN with him, can attest. Our small group went down to tour the orphanage and identify a project that we could accomplish for the Catholic sisters of Casa de Cuna. We found a clean, orderly set of buildings around a courtyard lined with ferns and trees that only has a handful of adults to care for dozens of children. We brought some shelves and school supplies for the sisters on this trip, as the orphanage is a school for the older boys and girls as well as a home. The sisters seemed to enjoy talking and joking with us, even though most of us needed translators!

Casa de Cuna has four separate dormitory-style bedrooms. One bedroom is for the older boys, one for the older girls, one for the babies, and one for the toddlers. We found that the toddler room is the last room that needs a new coat of paint and curtains put up. Sister Belen, who is older the "Jaycee age" to say it gently, takes care of twenty-five toddlers all day, each day. We would like to help her by putting up curtains so the room can be darker when the children need to go to bed. We would also like to give the walls a fresh coat of paint. The Pet Encounter Therapy (P.E.T.) program offers the tactile benefit and unconditional love only animals can provide to senior homes, centers for abused children, Alzheimer's facilities, and hospitals. The Center's Therapeutic Riding program gives children and adults with physical and mental challenges the opportunity to enhance their strength, cognitive abilities, and confidence through weekly riding sessions on specially trained horses. The AniMeals program makes sure that dogs and cats get nutritious food even though their owners, who are seniors, can't go to the store regularly.
